

Worship Attendance. Students must attend worship services regularly. Attendance is required for all students in the program.

Final Exams. Students must pass all final exams. Failure to pass a final exam may result in a student being required to repeat the course.

Residency Requirements. Students must meet the residency requirements of the university.

Time Limits on Degrees. Students must complete their degree within a specified time frame.

Transfer Credit. Students may receive credit for courses completed at other institutions.

PROGRAMS

M.Div. The Master of Divinity program is designed for students who wish to pursue a career in ministry. The program includes coursework in biblical studies, theology, and practical ministry.

M.A. The Master of Arts program is designed for students who wish to pursue a career in education, counseling, or social work. The program includes coursework in psychology, sociology, and education.

M.Ed. The Master of Education program is designed for students who wish to pursue a career in education. The program includes coursework in educational theory, research, and practice.

M.S. The Master of Science program is designed for students who wish to pursue a career in business, health care, or technology. The program includes coursework in business administration, health care management, and information technology.

M.B.A. The Master of Business Administration program is designed for students who wish to pursue a career in business. The program includes coursework in business strategy, finance, and marketing.

MDiv: Master of Divinity

The Master of Divinity program is a two-year program of study that prepares students for ministry. The program includes coursework in biblical studies, theology, and practical ministry.

Students who complete the M.Div. program will be eligible for ordination in many denominations. The program also provides a strong foundation for students who wish to pursue a Ph.D. in theology.

The M.Div. program is designed to be flexible, allowing students to complete their degree in as little as two years. Students may also receive credit for previous coursework.

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AREAS OF EMPHASIS

Students may choose to emphasize their studies in one or more of the following areas. The M.A. program is designed to be flexible and to allow students to tailor their studies to their interests and needs. The following areas of emphasis are available:

CHRISTIAN MINISTRY

This emphasis is designed for students who are preparing for Christian ministry. The curriculum includes courses in biblical studies, church history, and practical ministry.

CHURCH HISTORY

This emphasis is designed for students who are interested in the history of the church. The curriculum includes courses in church history, theology, and practical ministry.

NEW TESTAMENT

This emphasis is designed for students who are interested in the New Testament. The curriculum includes courses in New Testament studies, church history, and practical ministry.

OLD TESTAMENT

This emphasis is designed for students who are interested in the Old Testament. The curriculum includes courses in Old Testament studies, church history, and practical ministry.

THEOLOGY AND CHRISTIAN PHILOSOPHY

This emphasis is designed for students who are interested in theology and Christian philosophy. The curriculum includes courses in theology, philosophy, and practical ministry.

WORLD MISSION

This emphasis is designed for students who are interested in world mission. The curriculum includes courses in world mission, church history, and practical ministry.

THESIS OPTION

Students may choose to complete a thesis as part of their M.A. program. The thesis option is designed for students who are interested in research and writing.

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
