MTh: Master of Theology

Director

The MTh program is designed for students who have completed a Master of Divinity (M.Div.) or equivalent degree and wish to pursue advanced study in a specific area of theology. The program is flexible and can be completed in two years of full-time study. Students may choose from a variety of concentrations, including:

- Christian Ministry
- Church History
- New Testament
- Old Testament
- Theology and Christian Philosophy
- World Mission

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Students applying for the MTh program must have completed a Master of Divinity (M.Div.) or equivalent degree from an accredited theological institution. Applicants must also have a minimum GPA of 3.0 and must be recommended by their M.Div. faculty. The program is open to students of all denominations who are members of a Christian church.

1. Biblical Languages. Students must have completed at least one semester of Hebrew and one semester of Greek at the graduate level.

2. Modern Languages. Students must have completed at least one semester of a modern language (Spanish, French, or German) at the graduate level.

Admission Procedure. Applicants should submit their application, transcripts, and letters of recommendation to the MTh program director. The director will review the application and recommend admission to the program.
