TO MARCH IN GRADUATION

Students are authorized to march in the following criteria: (N)

1. Graduating in a Spring or Summer semester without a thesis or project and having completed more than 4 semester credits toward a graduate degree requirement in the program). *Credits*

or

2. Completion of a thesis or project and passing comprehensive exams (if required) and approval of thesis/project approval committee, published on Friday, 10:00 am on Friday, one week before the ceremony.

or

3. Completion of an undergraduate degree which could be expected to be completed within one year.

or

4. Completion of all coursework, including comprehensive exams, and approval of the approval committee. *Credits lacking in*

or

5. Completion of all coursework, including comprehensive exams, and approval of the approval committee. "Accept the dissertation/project with minor revisions." If the result is "Accept the dissertation/project with major revisions" within 11:30 am on Friday.

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
