


Figure 2. Student participation in service activities




Figure 6. Mission ratings, highest to lowest (n=361) 6161i61i6161610.8




Figure 8. Spiritual Commitment ratings, highest to lowest (n=361)

Demographics

Students in this year's senior class reported the following demographic characteristic

- x 367 seniors were surveyed 63 completed most or all of the survey
- x 84% of respondents identified themselves as Sevelath Adventists
- x 60% of respondents studied primarily at an SDA academy34% dstudied primarily at a public high school before comintor Andrews University
- x 58% of respondents were female
- x 44% of respondents were 22 or 23 years old, w26% were aged 42 or older.
- x 68% of respondents identified most closely with an ethnic group other than Caucasian
- x 25% of respondents were international udents
- x 26% of respondents were most fluent in a language other than English, or felt equally fluent in English and another language
- x 9% of respondents said they would graduate as a J.N. Andrews Scholar
